Procurement of Consultancy Services for Carrying out the Feasibility Study on Development of Sediment Removal & Management Strategy for Selected Major Reservoirs under MASL, Sri Lanka

The Ministry Consultants Procurement Committee (CPCM) on behalf of the Mahaweli Authority of Sri Lanka (MASL), which is functioning under the State Ministry of Canals and Common Infrastructure Development in Settlements in Mahaweli Zones, invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services described herein.

Observations have been revealed that the Capacities of the Major Reservoirs, in Mahaweli river basin and Kala Oya basins, are being decreased day by day, at an alarming rate. Accordingly, Victoria, Randenigala, Rantambe, Polgolla, Bowathenna and Kala Wewa Reservoirs have been identified for carrying out the Feasibility Studies on the Development of Sediment Removal & Management Strategy. The selected Multipurpose Reservoirs are located across Mahaweli river and Kala oya in Nuwaraeliya, Kandy, Badulla, Mathale and Anuradhapura Districts, respectively.

It is expected to improve the productivity of the above reservoirs towards higher Hydropower generation and Irrigation releases in future based on the final outcomes of the study. The objectives of the study of carrying out a Feasibility Study on the Development of Sediment Removal & Management Strategy for the selected Reservoirs are,

- a) Carrying out the feasibility study with the economic analysis to determine the proposed EIRR, NPV and other appropriate economic indicators with sensitivity analysis of the Cost and Benefits.
- b) Preparation of Cost Estimates and Bidding Documents for the implementation of the proposed Strategy.

The benefits of the strategy will be taken, based on the sediment utilisation management for the desilted materials by considering the market opportunity (for ex; sand, fertilizer, clay for different industries, etc..).

Eligibility Requirements

The interested firms shall provide relevant details including the following information to support their eligibility for qualifying and undertaking the Assignment.

The shortlisting criteria will be based on;

- a) Company Registration with its profile
- b) Name and CVs of the key staff of the firm for the Assignment
- c) Audited financial statements for the most recent 05 years
- d) List and details of major similar assignments completed by the firm during last 10 years. (The firm should complete 2 or more similar assignments)
- e) Broachers and other supporting documents and any relevant documents in proof of their eligibility

Therefore, the firm should provide necessary details/information as requested above with **01 original and 05 copies** for shortlisting along with the EOI. Qualified and interested local firms/ Joint Venture shall submit their applications along with the documents to prove their qualifications. The foreign firms shall also be acceptable, if they have formed Joint Venture with one or more local firms, when submitting their applications as described above.

The Consultant will be selected in accordance with the Quality and Cost Based Selection (QCBS) set out in the Consultant Guidelines for the Selection and Employment of Consultants, published by National Procurement Agency of Sri Lanka.
