PREAMBLE TO THE BILL OF QUANTITIES& LIST OF WORKS

1. LOCATION & NATURE OF THE WORK

The site is located in Official Village, Digana. All road network containing main roads and cross roads in the village to be rehabilitate through this contract, and it isn't possible to totally close the roads such that make disturbances to the mobility of the area. Most of the time the contractor will have to operate on a single side of roads at once, in section wise. Therefore working area shall be isolated by using barricades, safety cones, etc... Multiple sections can be rehabilitated at once and shall be selected jointly by the Contractor and the Engineer by considering the easiness of work execution with ensuring the mobility of the area. Allocated sections have to be totally completed before move to another.

2. RATES AND PRICES

The bill of quantities (BOQ) and this preamble shall be read in conjunction with all the other documents forming the contract, for details of all conditions, obligations, liabilities and instructions which shall be complied with by the Contractor. The cost of complying with all such conditions (like mentioned in above paragraph and not limited to those), obligations, liabilities and instructions including all charges for overheads profits shall be deemed to be spread over and included in the rates or sums inserted by the Contractor in the BOQ where they are not themselves covered by specific bill items. In case of the taxes only the value added tax (VAT) will be separately paid.

All items of the work shall comply exactly with the contract unless otherwise approved by the Engineer and the rates and the sum inserted in the BOQ shall be deemed to apply to the work as specified. If, for his own convenience or reasons of availability, the Contractor proposes and the Engineer approves the use or provision of alternative items, materials or methods of working of equivalent or superior quality to those specified in the Contract, the rates and sums inserted in the BOQ shall not in any case be increased as a result.

3. QUANTITIES

The quantities of work and other items set forth in the BOQ are estimate only and are not to be considered as limiting or extending the amount of work to be done and other items to be provided by the Contractor. But any considerable variation of quantities with the BOQ must be informed to the Engineer for approval prior to its execution. The works as completed in accordance with the contract shall be measured and paid in accordance with the provision of the contract.

Where, for his own purpose or due to his default, the Contractor carries out the works in such a manner that the quantity of any item of work in a particular component to be measured for payment purposes differs from that shown on the drawings or directed by the Engineer, then payment shall

be made according to the lesser of the actual quantity and that so shown or directed. An excess quantity in one part of the component shall not however be allowed to offset a deficit elsewhere in the same component for measurement purposes. Where the determination for payment purposes of the quantity of any items of the work depends upon the measurement of existing features or ground level and the like, then prior to carrying out any operations which might affect such measurement, the contractor shall first take such levels and measurements as the Engineer may direct and, after the Engineer has had the opportunity to check the same, they shall be certified as agreed by both Engineer and the Contractor. In the event that the Contractor fails to observe the above procedure, the Engineer shall determine the quantity to be assumed for payment purposes using the best information available to him, and his decision in the matter shall be final.

Item in the BOQ marked "PROVISIONAL QUANTITY" or "PROVISIONAL ITEM" shall only be executed if they are the subjects of a written instruction from the Engineer. The Contractor is expected to substantiate his claims under these items, where applicable, with appropriate invoices, receipts etc. The rates set out for such items shall be used for the payment of the work so ordered by the Engineer, whether the quantities shown are used wholly or in part or not at all.

4. UNITS

1). Provisional Sum Items in Schedule 1 of the Bill of Quantities

For Provisional Sum items under Schedule 1, the Contractor is expected to substantiate his claims where applicable, with appropriate invoices, receipts etc.

2). Lump Sum items in schedule 1 Bill of Quantities

Item No 2.1 - Preparation of shoulders and drainage system

Sub Item 2.1.1 Trimming / Cambering both sides of the existing road by Motor Grader

This sub item provides for trimming / cambering both sides of the existing road by motor grader up to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

The required area shall be, marked according to instructions of the Engineer and get approved before starting the work. **Measurement for payment shall be the trimmed** / cambered area as per the approval.

Sub Item 2.1.2 Excavation drainage line in Medium Soil

This sub item provides for excavation of drainage lines at the required areas as per instructions of the Engineer.

The depth of excavations will depend on the levels of existing drainage network. The existing ground levels before excavations and final bottom levels of excavated drainages shall be jointly taken by the Contractor and the Engineer. **Measurement for payment shall** be the in-situ volume of the excavated soil (i.e. volume of excavated drainages).

Sub Item 2.1.3 Approved soil [Type I and II Materials] excavation using machinery for bases and shoulder construction including loading and pilling and compacting using ½ to 1 Ton vibrating roller including watering with transport up to 3 km

Item No 2.2 - Road Preparation

Sub Item 2.2.1 Furnishing, mixing and laying using concrete mixer, cement concrete 1:2:4 (19mm) (Volume Batching) using crusher run aggregate

This sub item provides for furnishing, mixing, placing, providing construction joints, compacting and curing cement concrete 1:2:4 (19mm) for road surface, all inclusive of concrete related works excluding formwork. Mixing shall be done by using concrete mixer. The preparation of existing road surface for concreting, is also included in the item and the approval for the prepared surface have to be taken from the Engineer. The concreting shall be done in the presence of a nominated member of the Engineer's staff.

This sub item provides for supplying and fixing 25 mm thick planks and struts of class II timber as formwork for road surface concreting. Approval for the formwork have to be taken from the Engineer before start concreting.

Measurement for payment shall be the area of formwork measured according to the thickness and length of the concrete road.

Sub Item 2.2.3 Clearing and removing silting materials and other debris on the roadway and pot holes with preparation of pot hole edges such that to increase the bonding strength between newly treated pot holes and the existing roadway as directed by the engineer

This sub item provides for clean the roadway and pot holes with removing silting material and other debris and prepare the surface and edges of pot holes as per instructions of the Engineer to ensure the strength of the bond between existing roadway and newly treated pot holes.

The written approval for the above prepared surfaces shall be taken from the Engineer before starting the patching.

Measurement for payment shall be actual labour days spent for this specific task. The contractor shall daily prepare a list of allocated labours for morning and evening shifts for this task and get certification of the Engineer. These certified sheets have to be attached to progress claims to make payments.

Sub Item 2.2.4 Patching shallow pot holes, depth less than 20 mm using 10-20% cutback Bitumen 1.2ltr/Sq.m and 12.5 mm Chips, single size at 13.75 CuDeci m/ Sq.m including hand tamping

This sub item provides for patching shallow pot holes which have depth less than 20 mm by using the material specified in the item description including hand tamping.

The areas where have pot holes less than 20mm depth shall be jointly identified and marked by the Contractor and the Engineer, after the completion of sub item 2.2.3 for the selected section. The written approval for marked areas shall be taken from the Engineer before starting the patching.

Patching shall be done in the presence of a nominated member of the Engineer's staff. Measurement for payment shall be the approved area for patching as aforementioned.

Sub Item 2.2.5 Patching medium pot holes, depth of 20 – 75 mm with Premix (site made) using 10-20% cutback at the rate of 83.5 Ltr/Cu.m of 19 mm Down aggregate including preparation of Surface, Tack Coat (CSS1) at .75 Ltr/Sq.m Trimming sides, tamping etc

This sub item provides for patching medium size pot holes which have depth of 20 - 75 mm by using the material specified in the item description including side trimming, tamping, etc...

The areas where have pot holes which have depth of 20 - 75 mm shall be jointly identified and marked by the Contractor and the Engineer, after the completion of sub item 2.2.3 for the selected section. The written approval for marked areas shall be taken from the Engineer before starting the patching.

Patching shall be done in the presence of a nominated member of the Engineer's staff. Measurement for payment shall be the approved area for patching as aforementioned.

Sub Item 2.2.6 Chip sealing with bitumen (Hot Tar) at the rate of 1.5 Ltr/ Sq.m rate of 1.5 Lter/Sq.m rate of 125 Sq.m/ Cu.m and including Brushing, Cleaning Binding

This sub item provides for chip sealing with bitumen (Hot Tar) as specified in the item description including brushing, cleaning and binding.

The required area for chip sealing shall be jointly identified, inspected and marked by the Contractor and the Engineer, and get approved before starting the work. The work shall be executed in section wise.

Chip sealing shall be done in the presence of a nominated member of the Engineer's staff and the **measurement for payment shall be the approved area as aforementioned.**

Sub Item 2.2.7 Compacting the road with Pneumatic roller after Chip Sealing

This sub item provides for compacting the road with pneumatic roller after finishing the chip sealing
